



## Georgianna "Georgie" Lancucki

November 17, 1930 - July 19, 2020

Georgianna Lancucki, cherished wife, mother, and grandmother, died after a 5 month battle with cancer on Sunday, July 19, 2020 at the age of 89.

Georgie is survived by her sister, Linda Vellekoop, her daughter, Debora Jordan, her son, Steven Lancucki, and her three grandchildren: Rebekka, Nikkole, and Chad Lancucki, as well as her dog, Margie. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Eugene Lancucki.

Georgianna was born on November 17, 1930, in Somerville, New Jersey to parents Le-Roy and Beatrice Dibble. On September 23, 1951, she married the love of her life, Eugene Lancucki, and on December 4, 1956, they welcomed their first child, Debora; 10 years later on February 20, 1967, they welcomed their son, Steven, into the world. In 1977, the family moved to Mesa, Arizona, and on January 8, 1981, Eugene tragically passed away, at which point Georgie continued to care for and raise her children with plenty of love and support on her own. Georgie then welcomed her first grandchild, Rebekka, on February 9, 1994, her second grandchild, Nikkole, on January 30, 1997, and her third grandchild, Chad, on March 27, 2000; she was also affectionately known as "Bamma" after the birth of her grandchildren. Throughout her life, Georgie loved and valued many dogs, most recently becoming a dog-mother to Holly, Cory, and Margie.

Georgie was well-known and loved for her strong-willed and sassy personality. She always spoke her mind and was honest with everyone, and she never failed to stand her ground. She took pride in a clean house and looking and feeling presentable, and ensured her yard was cared for by tending to her flowers and feeding the birds and other animals that passed through it. She loved to cook and bake, and her family always looked forward to holiday gatherings at her house, which Georgie enjoyed above all else. Georgie, or "Bamma," took immense pride in her children and grandchildren, and would brag about them to friends (or strangers) any chance she could get for as long as they would listen.

As her favorite holiday was Christmas, Georgie's funeral service is scheduled for

Christmas in July on Saturday, July 25, 2020 at 9:00 am at the Mesa Cemetery. The graveside service is only for close friends and family due to COVID-19.
